END-USER LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR FILE JUGGLER. IMPORTANT PLEASE READ THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE CONTINUING WITH THIS PROGRAM INSTALL: Bitvaerk's End-User License Agreement ("EULA") is a legal agreement between you (either an individual or a single entity) and Bitvaerk for the File Juggler software product identified above which may include associated software components, media, printed materials, and "online" or electronic documentation ("SOFTWARE PRODUCT"). By installing, copying, or otherwise using the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, you agree to be bound by the terms of this EULA. This license agreement represents the entire agreement concerning the program between you and Bitvaerk, (referred to as "licenser"), and it supersedes any prior proposal, representation, or understanding between the parties. If you do not agree to the terms of this EULA, do not install or use the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.

The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is protected by copyright laws and international copyright treaties, as well as other intellectual property laws and treaties. The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is licensed, not sold.

1. GRANT OF LICENSE.

The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is licensed as follows:

(a) Installation and Use.

Bitvaerk grants you the right to install and use copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT on a single computer running a validly licensed copy of the operating system for which the SOFTWARE PRODUCT was designed [Windows Vista, Windows 7, Windows 8]. The SOFTWARE PRODUCT may be installed on multiple computers, if used by a single person for non-commercial purposes.

(b) Backup Copies.

You may also make copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT as may be necessary for backup and archival purposes.

(c) Evaluation period

The SOFTWARE PRODUCT may be used for a maximum of 30 days for evaluation purposes. After purchasing a registration key from Bitvaerk, you may use the SOFTWARE PRODUCT for an unlimited period of time.

2. DESCRIPTION OF OTHER RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS.

(a) Maintenance of Copyright Notices.

You must not remove or alter any copyright notices on any and all copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.

(b) Distribution.

You may not distribute registered copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT to third parties. Evaluation versions available for download from Bitvaerk's websites may be freely distributed.

(c) Prohibition on Reverse Engineering, Decompilation, and Disassembly.

You may not reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, except and only to the extent that such activity is expressly permitted by applicable law notwithstanding this limitation.

(d) Rental.

You may not rent, lease, or lend the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.

(e) Support Services.

3. TERMINATION

Without prejudice to any other rights, Bitvaerk may terminate this EULA if you fail to comply with the terms and conditions of this EULA. In such event, you must destroy all copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT in your possession.

All title, including but not limited to copyrights, in and to the SOFTWARE PRODUCT and any copies thereof are owned by Bitvaerk or its suppliers. All title and intellectual property rights in and to the content which may be accessed through use of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT is the property of the respective content owner and may be protected by applicable copyright or other intellectual property laws and treaties. This EULA grants you no rights to use such content. All rights not expressly granted are reserved by Bitvaerk.

5. NO WARRANTIES

7. PRIVACY POLICY

File Juggler tracks and submits information about errors as descriped below, if the user accepts this during install or when an error occurs.

File Juggler does not track or submit any other information.

Error Reports

When installing, File Juggler will ask your permission to submit reports about errors that could occur when running the program. If you accept, File Juggler will automatically submit error reports when an error occurs. If you decline, File Juggler will ask for your permission to submit the error report again, when the error occurs. If you decline, no information will be sent.

The report will also contain the information:

- Name of the computer, eg. SIMONS-PC.
- Username: The account name of the current user, which might be the full name of the user.

The error report will contain technical information about the error, that allows the developer to track the error to a point in his source code where the error occurs. This makes it possible to fix the problem.

The report is submitted to the Sentry.io service, but will not be shared or viewed with any 3rd party apart from Sentry.io.
